## VINTAGE PORT 2015

Cockburn's was founded in 1815 by Robert Cockburn, of Scottish origins. In 2015 Cockburn's celebrated its 200th birthday and to honor this milestone has released its declared Bicentenary 2015 Vintage. In the upper Douro Valley, Quinta do Canais is Cockburn's premier vineyard, whose wines form the backbone of its famed Vintage Ports. Known for its innovative vineyard practices Cockburn's was instrumental in promoting and conserving the indigenous Touriga Nacional grape varietal.

### 2015 VINTAGE

The viticultural year in 2015 was dry with 31% less rain than average, but July and August were relatively cool. The best grapes were picked from the 21st until October 4th; these were the 13 days when the finest Ports were made in the Douro Superior.

### TASTING NOTE

Great vitality and purity of fruit, focused and precise. Exudes freshness, which springs out of the glass. Aromas of fleshy, black plums and eucalyptus fragrance. Flavors of red cherries on the palate. Well-toned and muscular, full-flavoured with typical Cockburn's grip.
