Dow's 10 Year Old Tawny

Aged for 10 years in the Boa Vista Lodge, Dow's 10 Year Old retains bright fruit flavors combined with an intense complexity from prolonged ageing in well-seasoned oak. This Port's color has a deep russet center with a distinctive garnet edge and a hint of amber and bright aromas of red cherry and almonds with toffee and vanilla notes balance the nose. On the palate this wine is mouth-filling, with peppery spice and a touch of marmalade. The finish is full, with Dow's trademark dry edge.

Dow's 20 Year Old Tawny

For some, Dow's 20 Year Old is the perfect example of an aged tawny Port, an elegant balance of mellow fruit combines with the complex characteristics from prolonged wood-ageing.

With a polished brown center and orangeamber edges, this wine has a honeysuckle scent with discreet butterscotch notes. Refined and balanced on the palate, flinty and mellowed tannins meld with concentrated red berry fruit and lifted mineral freshness. Nuanced flavors of tobacco lead to a focused, dry finish.

Dow's 30 Year Old Tawny

Three decades of maturation in seasoned oak has mellowed the fruit and has provide Dow's 30 Year Old with layers of complex aromas and flavours that only long wood-ageing can produce.

With coppery-amber tones framed by a pale orange-green rim, this wine has saline scents alongside elegant floral notes and a touch of cinnamon. Luxurious and silky on the palate, Dow's 30 Year Old Tawny is extremely refined with flavors of quince and citrus and a stylish, lingering dry finish with nuances of tea leaf.
