 Six Grapes is the **Leading Reserve Port in the United States** by Value.

 Six Grapes is full bodied, rich black fruit profile means it pairs beautifully with **dark chocolate** desserts and **mature cheeses**.

 Sourced from **Graham's own estates**, Six Grapes is a blend of **vintage port quality** grapes.

 **100% indigenous Douro grape varieties** including Touriga Franca; Touriga Nacional; Tinta Roriz; and Tinta Barroca.

 Six Grapes is **aged for two years** in seasoned oak vats which preserves its **youthful, fruity character**.

The Six Grapes symbol originated in the 19th century. Following each harvest, Graham's winemakers would mark barrels of complex, structured and balanced port with the Six Grapes symbol. By the early 1900s, Graham's had started producing a reserve port selected from these barrels. Since then, Six Grapes has continued to be Graham's signature reserve port.
